1 APRIL 1945

Throughout most of the day the regiment maintained positions occupied on the 31 March 1945. Verbal orders from the CG, 90th Division, ordered the regiment to stand fast and push reconnaisance forward in the zone. Later in the day, the 2nd Bn was moved forward in the zone to protect the division right flank in the vicinity of the towns of Bodes (418470), Rothenkirchen (389378), and Eisterfeld (454423) - occupying the positions by 2200. The mission of the 2nd Bn was to protect the division right flank; blocking all routes, and patrolling all roads in the area.

2 APRIL 1945

The advance of the regiment continued at 0700. Bn moved out with companies B, A, and C, followed by Hq and The Bn's armor was split between the two leading companies the TD's operating with A Co and the tanks with B Co. The route of the Bn passed through the towns of Wehrda (362396), Rhina (375424), Nuekirchen (383431), Meisenbach (394450), Odensachsen (396461), Bodes (418471), Fischbach (430480), Erdmannrode (446479), Wustfeld (463493), Schenksolz (473513), Motzfeld (495522), Friedewald (492558), Herfa (538566), Wolferhausen (588555), Bengendorf (578570).

The 3rd Bn proceeded at 0645 in its zone. At 1645, a

K Co patrol captured 44 PWs after a fight at Bengendorf. After overcoming scattered resistance, K Co reached Ransbach (530495), and L Co closed in Ausbach (533516). I Co reached

Heimboldsheim (560530) along the Werra River.

The 2nd Bn continued its mission of securing the division rt flank, and at 1930, F Co, reinforced, established road blocks (nos 1 to 7) while the remainder of the Bn closed for the night in the vicinity of Malkomes (466524).

At 2300 the 1st Bn reported securing a railroad bridge across the Werra river with some troops across on the opposite side. Though the bridge was suitable only for foot troops, it was desirable in anticipation of an early crossing of the river on the following morning.

The remainder of the battalion was disposed as follows: A co on the rt holding the high ground south of Wolferhausen (586554) along the river; B Co on the left holding the northern half of Wolferhausen (586554) and Begendorf (578570); C Co in the town of Wolferhausen. The Bn CP remained in the vicinity of Herfa (538566).

With the close of the days operations, the regiment made plans to attack to the E across the Werra river on the follow-

ing morning.

At 0600 the 1st Bn crossed the Werra River with Co B following the 357th Inf at Widdershausen (602593), Co C following later at the same site. B Co proceeded to Hiringen (597567), Lengers (590541), Harnrode (573536), and Phillipsthal (598616). C Co followed B Co as far as Hiringen and then moved SE through the woods to capture Obertella (621515) at dusk. Meanwhile, A Co crossed the river at 1300 at the RR bridge site at 588561 and attempted to follow C Co but met stubborn resistance in the woods causing some delay and effecting some casualties. Contact was eventually made between C Co and A Co, however, and at 1900 the two companies abreast attacked the town of Oberzella. C Co remained in Oberzella while A Co continued the attack to secure the high ground on Pl B. B Co and the Bn CP were established at Phillipsthal (598616).

The 3rd Bn moved out at 0700 with I on the left, K Co on the right and L Co in reserve. The town of Unterbreizbach (580488) was set afire by artillery when civilians in the town offered resistance. By noon K Co had reached the town of Vacha (610500) and was engaged in a fight at the outskirts. Heavy mortar fire and some 20mm fire was received in the town from the high ground on the left as the battalion fought its way through. By 1800, the entire town of Vacha had been cleared. By dark the companies were in position along Pl B

which followed, generally, the Felda River.

The 2nd Bn continued its blocking mission along the rt flank, moving forward to occupy a block as the designated location was reported cleared by elements of the assault battalions. The Bn CP was established at Ramsbach (530495).

The regimental CP staged forward to Lautenhausen (512545) and later to Heimboldshausen (560530). At 1800 an enemy plane flew directly over the town and crashed some distance away from the regimental CP. As it flew over, it detonated a boxcar loaded with explosives. The explosion demolished most of the buildings in the town and caused heavy casualties among the various headquarters of the attached units and in the headquarters company of the regiment.

The regiment continued the attack to the east at 0700 as the 1st Bn captured Springen (665550) and released 89 British PsW. A company moved to the road junction at 693536. C Co followed B Co, and captured Kieselbach (680519). B Co moved NE from there to the road junction at (693536), then SE to Tiefenort to Offerrohn (742523) and Gumpelstadt (799520) where it closed for the night. C Co proceeded to Witzelroda (797503) and closed for the night. The 3rd Bn attacked with I Co on the left, L on the rt and K in reserve. A K co motor patrol contacted enemy at Immelborn in midafternoon marking the first enemy contact for the Bn in the day. Some artillery fire landed on a crossroad near Kaiseroda which later proved to be friendly fire. I Co crossed the Werra River and secured Barchfeld, while L Co moved to Immelborn followed by the Bn CP. K Co was dispatched to secure the bridge captured at Bad Salzungen. The co crossed the bridge and joined I Co at Barchfeld.

The regimental CP after stopping in Vacha and setting up at Merkers was finally established at the Kurhaus in Bad Salzungen. During the days operations, the 3rd Bn captured a salt mine that proved to be of great importance — for found in the mine was the entire Reich gold reserve and a storehouse

of priceless art treasures.

The 2nd Bn assembled in the vicinity of Tiefemont.

Continuing the attack to the E at 050700, the 3rd Bn pushed into Bad Liebenstein and captured the high ground east of the town, prior to the close of the period. The 2nd Bn passed through the 1st Bn at Witzelroda, meeting no resistance and clearing the town of SCHWEINA, moving to the high ground E thereof. The regiment was ordered to halt there pending further instructions. Per verbal instructions, CG, 90th Inf Div, the regiment made plans to assemble south of the Werra river early the following morning.

6 APRIL 1945

At 0600 the 1st Bn moved on foot into an assembly area at Wildprechtroda (768473) and remained there for the day. The 2nd Bn was relieved by elements of the 87th Div and assembled in Langenfeld, with elements of G Co remaining to guard the bridge at Bad Salzungen. Relief of the 3rd Bn was completed by 1400 by elements of the 345th Inf of the 87th Div,



and the Bn assembled in its area, vicinit, of Immelborn. The regimental CP remained at Bad Salzungen.

The regiment moved motorized to the new assembly area in the vicinity of ZELLA MEHLIS (0633). The Regimental CP opened in Goldlauter (130300) at noon. The 1st Bn assembled in that vicinity at 1145. From there, the Bn passed through the 359th Inf and attacked to the east in a column of companies. Heavy resistance was encountered at 150305 effecting some casualties. After overcoming the opposition, the Bn moved to Stutzerbach (2130), defended primarily by the Volkstrum, and remained there for the night.

The 2nd Bn from its assembly area at Goldlauter moved at 1500 to secure Pl A. By night, the Bn had reached the RR tracks NE of Schmiedeldeld (1828), after meeting slight resistance consisting mostly of s/a and a/w.

The 3rd Bn moved to Heidersbach (120305), and then sent K and L Cos to Stutzerbach, with I Co and the Bn CP remaining at Heidersbach.

Great difficulty was experienced in clearing hazardous supply routes through the mountains. Road blocks presented the greatest obstacle in extremely rugged, wooded terrain.

At 0730 the 1st Bn moved out in column of cos with co B leading to 233280 where B Co moved NE along the main road in the sector. Co A proceeded without resistance to hill 766 (280275) where it remained for the night. B Co after eliminating scattered light resistance moved abreast of A Co and closed on hill 271 (277288) for the night. Co C and the Bn CP moved to Neustadt (264252). The 2nd Bn with G and F Cos leading moved to Neustadt and Altenfeld (280230) where E Co and the CP closed for the night. F Co occupied hill 810 while G Co took over hill 820. Some nebelwerfer fire was encountered during the day along with s/a and a/w fire. The 3rd Bn maintained its positions and continued in reserve status.

The attack continued at 0730. The 1st Bn proceeded with all three cos moving abreast. A and B Cos moved NE to take Mohrenbach (305298). C Co, meanwhile, attacked from Neustadt to capture the road junction at 299266 and the high ground about a kilometer to the north of the junction. Co G then continued NE taking Gillersdorf (321280) and, later, Bohlen (340260). A Co then moved east from Mohrenbach to capture hill 809 (323295) and then through the town of Gillersdorf to capture Friedersdorf (335280), and Willdenspring (345276). B Co staged forward to Gross Brietenbach (312251) with the battalion CP and became the reserve co. The cos remained in these positions for the night and Leter tied in with the 2ndBn on the high ground 1 Km SE of Bohlen (340260).

CosE and F continued the assault, negotiating the surrender of Gross Brietenbach. Co F pushed on to Oelze (334216) in the afternoon while Co G went on to Neuselbach, Co E capturing Katzhutte and occupying the hill east of the The Bn CP remained in the town of Katzhutte (350220).



The 2nd Bn moved out to the SE at 0730, Cos E and F leading, passing through Licthte, taking Wallendeerf and Spechtbrum. By 2000, the Bn had consolidated on objectives 7,8, and 9 with the Bn CP established at Spechtbrum.

The 3rd Bn was given the mission of capturing the town of Graphenthal. At noon the bn moved out with K Co in the assault mounted on tanks and TDs. Dusk found the Bn completely closed in Graphenthal after meeting slight resistance.

About 30 Km (11)



About 30 Kms were covered by the Bn, road blocks constituting the chief obstacle.

The attack on Hof, a town about 4 kms square, by the 3rd Bn began shortly after noon when the troops first reached the edge of the town, after the battalion had eliminated stubborn resistance in the vicinity of Koditz, on the way to Hof. Fighting continued in the town for several hours - requiring complete mopping up in all sectors. By 2300 the companies had occupied their positions for the night. Some activity took place during the night as the town still was not completely cleared.

The 2nd Bn, motorized, moved to Hirschberg with E Co while F Co took Frosen. Later in the day, F Co moved from Hirschberg to 979089 while E Co occupied Tonen (939070). Co G moved to Hirschberg with the Bn CP and remained in that location for the night.

The 1st Bn was moved early to the vicinity of Koditz (925005) and then was given the mission of holding a line between the 2nd and 3rd Bns. A Go contacted the 3rd Bn at Hof (976001). B Co contacted A Co at (968019), along the rail read and extended along the road north to the autobahn where it contacted 2nd Bn. The Bn CP was established in Unterkotzau (960013) for the operation.

The regimental command post proceeded first to Berg and later in the day to Koditz where it was established for the night.

In Hof the 3rd Bn captured a small arms factory, parachute factor, and several military hospitals. Also a great many PsW were captured during the day.

The attack continued to the SE at 0730 as 1st Bn moved along the main road from Tirschenreuth to a point 1 km south of the railroad where it turned to Liebenstein (301471), captured without opposition. In midafternoon the bn assembled, following the capture of Plossberg (290416), and after relief by the 3rd Bn, with A and B Cos in Schonkirch and C in Liebenstein and femained in those positions for the night.

By 1430 the 3rd Bn had closed in its area with I co between Plossberg and Ellenbach, L Co between Ellenbach and Puckersreuth

and K Co in reserve at Wildenau.

The Bn closed for the day with I Co outposting the Neuenhammer -OberBernrieth line and K Co in the town of Waldthurn with L Co and the Bn CP.

The 2nd Bn moved to the vicinity of Wildenau for the night with E co in Kalmreuth (270368), F Co in Ellenbach, and

G Co in Schlattein.

At 0800 the regiment attacked to secure a new line as indicated with 3rd Bn on the left and the 2nd Bn on the right. Both of the assault cos of the 3rd Bn encountered stubborn resistance, including heavy tank and SP fire with s/a and harrassing mortar fire. At least 2 tanks and 7 MGs were reported holding up the cos. During the action, 2 of the 3rd Bn tanks were knocked out. It being impractical to attain the objective before dark, the bn closed in and buttoned up in place in the vicinity of Capartice (662032).

The 2nd Bn likewise met stiff opposition with an estimated 4 enemy tanks holding up the advance. Chief resistance in the 2nd Bn sector was in the vicinity of 675015. After dusk the Bn buttoned up where it was preparing to continue the

attack in the morning.

The 1st Bn occupied two additional towns during the day, Hazelberg (584076), and Pila (587060), these changes completed by 1900, and affecting only two platoons of C Co. Contact was made with the 97th Div and plans were made for relief by elements of that division on the following day.
