266th Day in Germany 1 March 1945 - Thursday

Reiff Germany

Troops are to be paid to-day and all class "A" O's of the com-1400 panies are to report to Regt. A U.S.O. show was held for the Bn. and featured Roscoe Ates and his troupe. All copany clerks of the Bn. visited their respective companies to settle any problems the men may have. The Red Cross Clubmobile arrived with the usual hot coffee and do-nuts and the Bn. continues to prepare for the unit citation to be presented to-morrow, with the training schedule still in effect.

All Officers attend a nightly demonstration of serchlights held in 1800 vis. of Regt., stressing night attack by artificial moonlight. These schools are to be attended nightly. Capt. Morris asgd. and j'd. as Bn. Exec. O. Movies for to-night have been called off. See Administrative Memo no.2 from Bn. dtd. March '45 and training Memo dtd. 28 Feb. '45 Evacuations for to-day: Co. M- 16sld)

247th day in Germany 2 March 1945 - Friday

Reiff Germany

See Memo issued to all companies; - Subject, Parade, dtd. 2 March

Bn. prerares for Presidential Unit Citation to be awarded by the 0800 Division Commander at 1500, and Lt. Rugh is now a Captain. Training schedule for to-day is postponed due to preparation for presentation fo citation.

Div. Commander presented citation with a very impressive ceremony. 1500

Regt'l CO visits CP and compliments entire personnel for the splen-1630 did manner in which they carried out the cermony. A movie will be shown to the troops at 1730 and 1900.

The remainder of the day and night passed uneventfully. Lt. 2400 Reinel, MAC, was evacuated to-day - SLD, and the only evacuation for the Bn. to-day. WE are now in Div. reserve.

258th day in Germany 3 March 1945 - Saturday

Reiff Germany

Training schedule will be resumed to-day and a Clubmobile unit 0800 will be here sometime this morning with the usual cofee and do-nuts.

A reconnaissance party leaves CP to reconnoiter for a new area 1400

and contomplating a move to-morrow and Bn is given a warning order. The remainder of the day and night passed uneventfully and during 2400 the late afternoon and night, Bn CO and staff planned for possible movement.

251st day in Germany 4 March 1945 - Sunday

OCT 5 1944many

Bn sti S-1 is to leave CP at 0830 with a quartering party and movement will take place shortly after dinner. See March Order from Bn. dtd 4 March 1945. Protestant church services to be held 47446 at 1000

In CP closes out and moves by motor to new location. Bu of olders at new location at Winningen. All civilians are being apprehended by bn 8-2 section and Bn awaits further orders and contemplates another movement to- morrow. I and K Co's are billeted in Winningen but Land M are in Matzerath.

270th day in Germany Winringen Germany 5 March 1945 - Monday Bn still awaits further orders regarding movement. 0800 Col. Schultz, Regt'l Exec., visited CF and discusses matters in 1100 general. Also states that En will be committed to-morrow along with the 1st Bn.

See March order from Bn attached dated 5 Mar 45 1400

Bn S-3 returns fr Regt and says that if 357 or 359 have not 1420 crossed the river by to-night, we will cross to-morrow morning at 0400. If they have crossed, we will follow up the 11th Armd Bn S-1 leaves with a quartering party to new location and movement will commence at 1600.

Bn CP closes out and moves to new location. 1530 In CP arrives at new location at Wallersheim. 1900 Entire movement was by motor, long trip and cold and the entire area is jammed with 11th Armd troops and our own. In awaits further orders. 50'0 and 15 EM are to go to Paris to-morrow and 5 men from the Bn have been chosen to go home on a 30 day furlough on the 15th of the month. Lt Carraway leaves the Battal ion as the General's aid.

and L on the right. Ey sniper fire is reported in one of the 1435 builgs in the town and ey tanks at 554 are rptd to be headed for th e far end of town.

K is in the town and L is on the high ground to the right. Regt'l 1440 CO visits CP and discusses latest situation. Lt. Jones is to have hand carring party ready on call.

2 TD's are now across and the first Bn will come up on our right. 1500 Capt. Bryan is told over radio that to-nights objective will be town offPelm

Regt'l CO visits CP again and says we are to seize high ground 1510 off to the left and rights fronts and then tell CCA of the 11th

Arm'd to go thru us. Col Lydle of the 2nd Bn visits CP and is briefed by Lt. Crotty 2000 and his Bn is to relieve K Co. Lt. Rice is to guide him to Capt. Bryan's OP. After Col Lydle relieves us we will push on to the to of Pelm. Capt. Bryan requests TOT Arty fire on Pelm immediately as he can hear the ey and tanks in there. The remainder of the night was spent by Bn CO up at K Co area and he planned and plotted for a pre dawn attack on Pelm to-morrow About 41 Psw were taken for to-day.

27370 day in Germany Lissingen Germany 7 March 1945 - Wednesday Bn attacks town of Pelm. 0400 Troops have now seized Pelm and met quite a bit of artillery fire, 0830 Division Commander, Gen. Ernest, and Regt'l CO visits CP and awaits arrival of CG of 11th Armd to discuss latest situation. We are still waiting for a bridge to be put across the Kyel river so that the Bn rear CP and all En vehicles can come across. Once across we will most likely follow the 11th Armd right up to the Rhine. Troops are to attack high ground NE of Pelm now. Capt. Morris calls OP and gives Lt. Jones our new objective and we also learn that our TD's are in Pelm. Regt'l CO visits CP once again and requests information as to wether or not 0930 the tank traps around Pelm are passable. Dic. CG visits CP again. No report yet on progress of the 0935 troops Bn rear CP closes out and moves to new location at Pelm. 1030 Bn rear CP arrives at new location at Pelm. Movement of all 1120 personnel was by motor. I Co is at 277-835, K at 246-830 and L is at 256-823 and still 1225 moving rapidly, meeting with very little artillery as the only oposition. I Co is now at Essingen. Ey inf reported to the left of k Co 1400 and arty fire is to be placed there immediately. K Co reports by radio that they are on their objective and L Co 1435 on check point 605 From now to close fo period, 11th Armd passes thru Pelm and we keep road free of conjection. Recon was made for possible road to K Co in the event it becomes necessary to lead tanks up there. 2100 273ff day in Germany 8 March 45 - Thursday Pelm Germany Regt'l FM no. 1 dtd 07 March received. 0300 I Co patrol reported seeing one half-track, one 88 and 4 1025 Germans in open ground SE of Lilsdorf. Also passed within 300 yds of pillboxes in that area and reported no sign of occupancy. Investigation was conducted concerning the woman soldier 1900 captured yesterday by K Co. The Bn. received 100 reinforcements and 1 Officer 1700 Regt'l verbal order received. See Bn FO no.2 dtd 8 March '45. 1900 Plans were maid during the rest of the night concerning to-

morrows operation.

Capt. Bryan was promoted to Major to-day.

9 March 45 - Friday Bodenbach 8888 Regtl FM No. 2 dtd 9 March 45 received. Bn Intelligence Section (motorized) moved out to contact 0615 Major Bryan and S-3 left for Bettzendorf. All companies had checked out by now and were on the move. By utilizing attached tanks, TDs and AT platoon it was possible to have entire Bn motorized. 0645 Bn CP moved out. 0800 L Co has now cleared Oberehe. 0900 Bn CP arrived in Oberehe after coming through Gees, Bekrlingen Hohenfels, and Bettgendorf. Ron reported at 3897. 0915 1015 L Co left for obj 2 - Neinroth. 1100 Bn CP moved to Neinroth. 1200 Regtl FM No. dtd 9 March received. I and K Cos set out for objectives 2 and 4. 1300 1415 Bn CP left for Bodenbach. I Co is now in Borler. 1710 Task force Rudes is on obj - town of Welsemscheid. Requests troops to be moved up there. 1800 L Co moved on up to Weisemscheid. TF Rudes cleared Kaltenborn and netted 15 Psw. 2100 275th day in Germany 10 March 45 - Saturday Morswetsen 0300 FM No. 3 dtd 10 March 45 received. 0766 TF Morris (L Co, Hqs Co, TF Rudes, BN Motor Pool) moved out. They are to move by a southern route to a Bn assembly area. 0715 TF Bryan (I and K Co's on tanks and TDs) moved out. They are to move to the Bn assembly area by a northern route. 1200 BN CP closed in Morswetsen after passing through Wetsemscheid. Mullenbach, Hohenlenbach, Arft and Langenfeld. 1400 L Co closed in Wabern. 1410 I Co closed in Hausten. 1420 K Co closed in Hausten. En route we rode over part of the Autobahn. It was like a 4 lane highway in the states. 15 PsW were picked up during the trip; they were stragglers. Col Bealke visited the CP and discussed control of looting. 1500 1530 All Co COs gave their company a talk on control of looting. 1600 Radio from Regt. Secure objectime. Watch civilians. 2100 Regtl verbal order. Patrol woods to-morrow between present location and Weisemschein. 2105 Regtl verbal order. Forget about patrols and have recon party ready at 0900 to.morrow.
