We turned them back without any trouble and had them assemble in front of our lines. 1400 Lt Col Bryan, Lt Rise and Lt Jones left for Waldmunchen to examine 1500 the area.
Village dance starts in the ballroom above the CP. Music was played by the village band numbering about 30 pieces. Dance lasted 1505 Our outposts are moved to the N of the main road. Regtl CO visited the CP and urged increased vigilance on the part of the troops. Day passed without incident. Regtl CO informs that we should fire on these white Russians or Germans if they give us trouble. They are Red Russian Part and correct automated to the part of the part o 1600 1700 are Red Russian PsW and cannot surrender to us. Numerous Red Russian units passed through the town and the town-1900 people greeted each vehicle with much applause and shouts of " Vasda ". 338th Day in Ckechoslovakia Kasejovice 12 May 45 Saturday Outposts report that the White Russians numbering well over 3000 0900 men are again attempting to pass through our lines. All Cos are alert-K Co is moved out to block main road going S from Lnare. They are instucted to fire if necessary. 1000 Cos report that the White Russians have returned to their bivouack 1300 and all is quiet again. Lt Col Bryan and group return from Waldmunchen and report that area 1600 can be made quite livable with a little work. 13 May 45 Sunday 339th day in Czechoslovakia Kasejovice Catholic services were held in the village church. 0800 Protestant services were held in the ballroom above the Bn CP-All of our outposts N of the Main road are pulled back to the main 1100 1200 road. Our former positions are now occupied by the Russians.
