I--Award of Oak-Leaf Cluster to Silver Star--Under the provisions of Army Regulation 600-45 and Section I Circular 6, Third United States Army, 26 April 1944, in addition to the Silver Star previously awarded, a Bronze Oak-Leaf Cluster is awarded to:

FREDERICK H. LOOMIS, 0280778, Lieutenant Colonel, Infantry, United States Army, for gallantry in action in France on 11 July 1944. Entered Military Service from Utah.

II--Award of Silver Star--Under the provisions of Army Regulation 600-45 and Section I Circular 6, Third United States Army, 26 April 1944, the Silver Star is awarded to:

HARRIS C. NEIL, JR, 0348095, First Lieutenant, Infantry, United States Army, for gallantry in action in France on 8 September 1944. Entered Military Service from Texas.

PAUL B. EVANS, 38590053, Sergeant, Infantry, United States Army, for gallantry in action in France on 20 September 1944. Entered Military Service from Oklahoma.

CASPER J. AMLI, 36419183, Private First Class, Infantry, United States Army, for gallantry in action in France on 20 September 1944. Entered Military Service from Michigan.

FRANK E. POWER, 33534857, Private First Class, Infantry, United States Army, for gallantry in action in France on 19 August 1944. Entered Military Service from Virginia.

III--Award of Bronze Star--Under the provisions of Army Regulation 600-45 and Section I Circular 6, Third United States Army, 26 April 1944, the Bronze Star is awarded to:

PAUL J. HARLIS, 39399830, Technical Sergeant, Infantry, United States Army, for heroic achievement in connection with military operations against the enemy in France on 10 September 1944. Entered Military Service from California.
