I--Award of Silver Star--Under the provisions of Army Regulation 600-45 and Section I, Circular 6, Third United States Army, 26 April 1944, the Silver Star is awarded to:

JOHN F. OTRUBA, 38094244, Sergeant, Field Artillery, United States Army, for gallantry in action in France on 12 November 1944. Entered Military Service from Texas.

ELVIN L. MORSE, 37154720, Corporal, Field Artillery, United States Army, for gallantry in action in France on 10 July 1944. Entered Military Service from Wyoming.

II--Award of Bronze Star--Under the provisions of Army Regulation 600-45 and Section I, Circular 6, Third United States Army, 26 April 1944, the Bronze Star is awarded to:

JOE E. MUSGRAVE, 38019037, Technical Sergeant, (then Staff Sergeant) Field Artillery, United States Army, for heroic service in connection with military operations against the enemy in France on 3 July 1944. Entered Military Service from Oklahoma.

WARREN P. FOWLER, 35052823, Technician Fifth Grade, Field Artillery, United States Army, for heroic service in connection with military operations against the enemy in France during the period 9 - 10 November 1944. Entered Military Service from Ohio.

WILLIAM H. HILLS, 37154722, Technician Fifth Grade, Field Artillery, United States Army, for heroic achievement in connection with military operations against the enemy in France on 12 November 1944. Entered Military Service from Kansas.

MELVIN C. WASLEY, 39086411, Private First Class, Field Artillery, United States Army, for heroic achievement in connection with military operations against the enemy in France on 12 November 1944. Entered Military Service from California.
