I--Award of Silver Star--Under the provisions of Army Regulation 600-45 and Section I, Circular 6, Third United States Army, 26 April 1944, the Silver Star is awarded to:

CLINT W. BRACHER, 0396759, First Lieutenant, Field Artillery, United States Army, for gallantry in action in France on 17 November 1944. Entered Military Service from Texas.

II--Award of Bronze Star--Under the provisions of Army Regulation 600-45 and Section I, Circular 6, Third United States Army, 26 April 1944, the Bronze Star is awarded to:

PATRICK J. BARRY, 01169419, First Lieutenant, Field Artillery, United States Army, for heroic achievement in connection with military operations against the enemy in France on 3 and 4 October 1944. Entered Military Service from Connecticut.

ROBERT C. GOSSIN, 01177413, Second Lieutenant, Field Artillery, United States Army, for heroic service in connection with military operations against the enemy in France during the period 10 - 12 November 1944. Entered Military Service from Oklahoma.

III--Award of Third Oak-Leaf Cluster to Air Medal--Under the provisions of Army Regulation 600-45 and Section I, Circular 6, Third United States Army, 26 April 1944, in addition to the Air Medal and two Oak-Leaf Clusters previously awarded, a third Oak-Leaf Cluster to the Air Medal is awarded to:

EDWARD C. HICKS, JR., 01183537, First Lieutenant, Field Artillery, United States Army, for meritorious achievement while participating in aerial flight during the period 2 October to 12 November 1944 as Artillery Liaison Pilot. Entered Military Service from Oregon.

WILLIAM J. RHEIN, 01175555, First Lieutenant, Field Artillery, United States Army, for meritorious achievement while participating in aerial flight during the period 8 September to 7 October 1944 as Artillery Liaison Pilot. Entered Military Service from Illinois.


