- 1. G.O. No. 11, this Hq. dated 18 October 1943, is rescinded.
- 2. Until further orders the guard for Area T-10, Ft. Dix, N.J. will consist of an armed guard furnished by Companies A,B,C, 315th Engineer Combat Battalion and by 90th Rcn. Troop, Effective this date the guard will be composed of:-
 - 1 Officer of the Day 1 Sergeant of the Guard 3 Corporals of the Guard 6 Privates of the Guard
- 3. The company or troop which supplies the guard will also supply the Officer of the Day. Guard will be furnished by roster published by Hq. 315th Engr. Bn. The name of the Officer of the Day will be submitted to the Adjutant, 315th Engr. Bn. by 1500 on the day before he is to be on duty.
- 4. Guard Mount: Informal at 1645 daily in front of building No. T-10-34. Guard will be formed at 1645 daily and instructed by the New Officer of the Day in guard duty until retreat. The formation, inspection, and relief of the Guard will be as prescribed in F.M. 26-5, 2 Jan. 40 and Changes 1 and 2, Interior Guard Duty, Appendix 1, Paragraphs 3 and 4. The guard will be relieved by the Officer of the Day at 0700 daily at a formation in front of Building T-10-34.
- 5. The guard will be quartered on the 2nd floor of Bldg. T-10-34.
- 6. The 315th Engineer Battalion and the 90th Reconnaissance Troop will supply a guard for the Special Troops Stockade according to roster. This guard will be independent of the Area T-10 guard except in the following respects: when either organization is furnishing both guards:
 - a. The Officer of the Day may be Officer of the Guard.
- b. The guard may be quartered in the Special Troops Stock-ade instead of in Building No. T-10-34. If the guard is quartered in the stockade the Sergeant and the Corporals of the Area guard may also be the Sergeant and Corporals of the stockade guard. In this case one corporal will post reliefs while a second corporal remains alert within the stockade.
- 7. Uniform: Wool with leggins, helmet liner, overcoat, cartridge belt, under arms.
- 8. All members of the guard will be armed with their individual basic weapon.
 - 9. There will be two posts as follows: .

POST NO. I

Bounded by Newburgh Avenue, Atlantic Avenue, 16th Street and 17th Street.

POST NO. II

Bounded by Pennsylvania Avenue, Atlantic Avenue and 17th Street, except that it will include the Engr. Bn. Motor Pool south of 315th Engr. Bn. Hq.

- 10. To insure full coverage of their posts, sentinels will vary their route of walking their posts at frequent intervals.
- Il. Sentinels on duty will not enter buildings except in line of duty.
- . 12. When not on tour of duty sentinels will remain in building T-10-34 (2nd floor), in the stockade if quartered there, or in the immediate vecinity of those buildings.
- 13. The Sergeant of the Guard and the Corporal on relief will be in Building No. T-10-34, or in the stockade if quartered there, at all times except when at mess, latrine or on guard duties.
- 14. Sentinels will be on the alert for fires and unauthorized personnel in the Area. All suspicious persons will be challenged.
 - 15. The Officer of the Day Will:
 - a. Instruct the guard as prescribed in Paragraph 4 above.
- b. Keep the Sergeant of the Guard informed as to his where-abouts at all times.
 - c. Inspect each relief at least once.
- d. Be responsible for the proper ventilation of barracks buildings in the area. He will spot check at least four buildings each night. If buildings are not properly ventilated he will wake up senior NCO in the building and have him properly ventilate the building. He will indicate on the Officer of the Day check list the Numbers of the Buildings checked.
 - 16. All guard personnel will read and understand these orders.
