Pfc Leonard H. Fox, 38146934, for wounds received in action against the enemy on 17 August 1944 in France. Entered Military Service from Oklahoma.


Sgt Arthur Keenan, 32957425, for wounds received in action against the enemy on 17 August 1944 in France. Entered Military Service from New Jersey.
