These guard orders apply to the 359th Infantry Regiment y

Post at Amberg.

I. OFFICER OF THE DAY.

(a) Officer of the Day will remain in the Guard House at all times except when carrying out his official duty. Either the Officer of the Day or Sergeant of the Guard will be in the Guard House at all times.

(b) Officer of the Day will take a bed-check of one company each night after curfew hour. This check will be made between the hours of 2200 and 2400; companies will not be notified in advance. Officer of the Day may check any company he desires.

(c) Officer of the Day will check the Guard once (1) before midnight and twice (2) after midnight. Bach relief will be checked at least once during its tour of duty.

(d) Ofricer of the Day will turn the names, rank, ASN, and Organization of all enlisted men who enter the Post after curfew hour in to the Regimental Adjutant at 0900 each day.

II. REGULAR GUARD POSTS. (See Annex)

III. SPECIAL ORDERS.

Post No. 1.

(a) To allow no prisoners to leave the area except under appropriate authority and under adequate guard. (b) To allow no vehicles from the 359th Infantry except the Regimental Commander's to leave the Post without a trip ticket.

(c) To challenge and halt all persons and vehicles during the hours of darkness.

(d) To allow no unauthorized person to enter the Post at any time. No German Civilian will enter the Post unless he has a Pass signed by the 359th Infantry Military Government Officer.

RESERICIED

(Sec III RGO 73 Hq 359th Inf 1 June 45 Contd)

Post No. 2,3,4,5 and 6.

(a) Sentry will halt all persons, military or otherwise, trying to enter or leave the Post by getting across the fence surrounding the Post.

(b) In case of fire, to fire his rifle or pistol rapidly three times. Awaken the occupants of buildings on his Post and be propared to guide help to the location of the fire.

Post No. 7 and 8.

(a) Sentries will observe to the South, Southwest and West and report unusual activity within their field of observation, remaining alert to prevent unauthorized entry into the area.

Post No. 9.

(a) To keep all persons, Military or otherwise, from crossing the fence and entering the area.

Post No. 10.

(a) To allow no unauthorized person to enter the Regimental Headquarters Building at any time.

IV. Guard will be mounted at 1800 daily. (See Annex)

Vo. Double posts will be maintained at all times.

VI. Uniform - Regulation uniform unless otherwise specified.

VII. Guard will be responsible for raising and lowering the Post Flag daily, as provided in FM 26-5, ΔR 260-10 and ΔR 600-25.

VIII. The New Officer of the Day and the Old Officer of the Day will report to the Regimental Adjutant at 1700 each day.
